An Anniversary for the Record Books

At the March 15, 2016 Village Board meeting, Senator Tom Cullerton recognized Bartlett’s 125 years of incorporation by reading an anniversary proclamation and presenting the community with a congratulatory plaque from the Senate of the 99th General Assembly of the State of Illinois.

This kicked off a yearlong celebration that included flying anniversary banners in the downtown area, displaying an anniversary logo on t-shirts and printed material, having the Village Board serve as grand marshalls for the annual 4th of July parade, serving birthday cake at Bartlett Park during the Heritage Days festivities and exhibiting 125 years of Village history at the Bartlett History museum in Village Hall.

However, the year was truly capped off at the December 20 Board meeting, when Bartlett received its official Guinness World Record certificate for having the most people simultaneously blowing a train whistle during the National Night Out Picnic in the Park. With 1,569 people blowing train whistles in Bartlett Park on August 2, the Village officially “blew” past the previous record of 1,127, which was held by the Friends of the Chatham Historical Society in Chatham, New Jersey. Thank you to everyone in Bartlett for a “record-breaking” anniversary year!

Timeout with the Trustees



The Bartlett Police Department has been dominating the local headlines recently -- in a good way.

In December the Village was proud to accept the first place trophy in the 15,000 to 50,000 population category for the department's 2016 National Night Out (NNO) activities. The National Association of Town Watch organizes the annual National Night Out event in more than 16,000 communities nationwide, and the Village has been participating for the past 27 years.

The Village has claimed this award six times since 2002, making Bartlett a "go to community" for how to build community interaction and partnerships, according to Police Chief Kent Williams. As it turns out, this was Williams' last time accepting NNO honors on behalf of Bartlett before making a headline of his own.

Williams retired on January 3, and the Village has appointed Deputy Chief Patrick Ullrich as the new chief of police for the Bartlett Police Department.



Williams, who with nearly 32 years of service, is the longest tenured sworn employee in the history of the Bartlett Police Department. He joined the force in 1985 as a patrol officer and his leadership skills were immediately recognized, earning him the Ervin H. Warren Award for Excellence at the Basic Law Enforcement

Training Academy. He served as a detective before being promoted to sergeant in 1993, to commander of investigations in 2002 and to deputy chief of operations in 2005. Williams was appointed chief of the department in 2011.

In addition to many other accomplishments, the CALEA Gold Standard Accreditation was achieved twice during Williams' five-year tenure as chief.

We wish Williams and his family all the best and know that the department continues to be in good hands under the direction of Chief Ullrich.

The new chief has been with Bartlett for more than 18 years, serving as a patrol officer, crime prevention officer, D.A.R.E. instructor and emergency vehicle operator course instructor. He was promoted to the rank of sergeant in 2004, advanced to commander in 2006, and then to deputy chief in 2009. Bartlett is fortunate to have him assume this leadership position in the department.

Ullrich will be supported by newly promoted deputy chiefs Charles Snider and Geoffrey Pretkelis. Snider will head the operations division while Pretkelis will lead the department's support services.





Flood

FLOOD HAZARD AREAS

The Village of Bartlett has some floodplain areas. On the northwest side of town is the Brewster Creek Tributary. In the middle of town there is some floodplain in the Wayne Grove Forest Preserve. The northeastern part of the Village has the Brewster Creek floodplain, which flows to the West Branch of the DuPage River floodplain.

Information on whether your property is in the 100-year floodplain can be obtained by coming into the Village of Bartlett Building Department. Maps are available for viewing, as well as other flood-related information. Contact the Village of Bartlett Building Department, 630-837-0800 for further assistance.

NATURAL & BENEFICIAL FUNCTIONS

Floodplains play a valuable role in providing natural benefits to the Village of Bartlett and the surrounding area. Floodplains that are relatively undisturbed provide open spaces and aesthetic pleasure, as well as function for active processes, such as filtering nutrients.

Wayne Grove Forest Preserve and Hawk Hollow Forest Preserve floodplains are used to filter farm chemical runoff so that these areas can maintain biodiversity and ecosystem sustainability. Both floodplains contain historic and archeological sites that provide opportunity for education. Both enhance waterfowl, fish and other wildlife habitats and provide feeding/breeding grounds. And lastly, both floodplains provide natural erosion control and open space so further flooding damage does not occur.

FLASH FLOODS

Flash-flooding is the general type of flooding caused by heavy rain events. A flooding event can occur with 2 to 4 inches of rain in a 3 to 4 hour time period on some streets throughout the Village. Several detention areas may rise during these events. However, all of the Village streets are designed to additionally store stormwater for a period of time.

The Village experienced a record rain event in September of 2008; almost 9 inches of rain occurred in less than a 24-hour period. The Village has made several drainage improvements since then and is continually making improvements in the community.

DRAINAGE SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

As simple as it may sound, keeping smaller ditches and streams free of debris can dramatically improve the run-off capacity of low-lying areas and can greatly reduce the occurrence of blockage that significantly contributes to flooding.

It is illegal to dump materials into a required waterway and violators may be fined. If you see someone in the act of dumping or see debris in one of Bartlett's watercourses, please contact the Village Public Works Department at 630-837-0811.

Homeowners are responsible for maintaining their perimeter drainage swales. You may have a storm inlet in your yard; if you do, make sure to keep it clear of debris. If you have any flooding or drainage concerns on your property, the Village of Bartlett staff is available to assess your drainage

concerns. You can contact the Building Department at 630-837-0800.

PROPERTY PROTECTION MEASURES

If your property is susceptible to flooding, there are many flood damage reduction measures you can employ.

- Watertight seals can be applied to brick and block walls to protect against low-level flooding.
- Utilities, such as heating and air conditioning systems, water heaters and other major appliances can be elevated to higher floors in the structure or onto raised platforms.
- Temporary measures, such as moving furniture and other valuables to higher floors or sand-bagging exterior openings, will also help.
- Elevating or relocating the entire structure may also be a feasible option.

FLOODPLAIN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

All development within the 100-year floodplain (not just construction of buildings, but filling, excavation, fences, etc.) requires a Village development permit. Applications must be made prior to doing any work in a floodplain area.

Please contact the Village Building Department, 630-837-0800, to receive all the information you need to properly develop in the floodplain. You may report any illegal development activities to the above number as well.

FLOOD INSURANCE

If you do not have flood insurance, talk to your insurance agent. Most homeowner insurance policies do not cover damage from floods. Flood

insurance is only available to communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Because of Bartlett's floodplain management programs, which attempt to protect property owners from multiple flooding hazards, the Village is part of the NFIP. Bartlett residents are able to obtain flood insurance. Additionally, because the Village participates in FEMA's CRS program, flood insurance premiums are discounted.

Be sure to check your policy to ensure you have adequate coverage. Typical policies cover the building structure, but not the contents. Contents coverage can also be obtained by asking.

There is a 30-day waiting period before flood insurance coverage becomes effective. Plan ahead; do not wait until a flood is predicted before purchasing flood insurance. If you are building inside the floodplain and are using a federally regulated lender/bank for a loan, the purchase of flood insurance is mandatory.

SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT/DAMAGE

If the cost of improvements to a building or the cost to repair damages (from any cause) to a building exceeds 50% of the market value of the building (excluding land value), the NFIP requires that the entire building be brought up to current floodplain management standards. Building improvement projects include exterior and interior remodeling, rehabilitation, additions and repair and reconstruction projects. Please contact the Village of Bartlett

FLOOD WARNING SYSTEM

Many times, flooding of streets and parking lots in Bartlett can be predicted, allowing ample time for preparation and evacuation. However, in the event of a flash flood due to a large rain event, there may only be hours to execute a plan.

Once the Bartlett Police and Bartlett Fire Protection District are notified of an oncoming flood event, the Village's Emergency Alert System will be activated. The Village can send a Code Red or mass emergency notification

system alert to the entire Village or a specific neighborhood. Community alerts and additional safety information will also be posted to the Village website and cable television station.

FLOOD SAFETY

The following commonsense guidelines can protect you from the dangers of flooding:

- Do not drive through a flooded area. More people drown in cars than anywhere else. Do not drive around barriers.
- Do not walk through flowing water. Currents can be deceptive. Six inches of water can knock you off your feet.
- Stay away from power lines and electrical wires. If your house is about to be flooded, turn off the power at the service box. Electrical current can travel through water. Electrocutation is the second leading cause of death during floods.
- Be alert to gas leaks. Turn off the gas to your house before it floods. If you smell gas, report it to the Fire Protection District, the Village or your gas company. Do not use candles, lanterns or open flames if you smell gas or are unsure if your gas has been shut off.
- Keep children away from flood waters, ditches, culverts and storm drains. Flood waters can carry unimaginable items that have dislodged themselves. Culverts can suck in smaller people, rendering them helpless.
- Clean everything that has been wet. Flood water is contaminated with sewage and other chemicals, which pose severe health threats.
- Look out for animals, especially snakes. Small animals that have been flooded out of their home may seek shelter in yours.
- Do not use gas engines, such as generators, or charcoal fires indoors during power outages. Carbon monoxide exhaust can pose serious health hazards.

The automotive education programs at **Bartlett and South Elgin High Schools** recently earned accreditation from The National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF), certifying the high-quality instruction offered in these courses and making it more likely that students will be ready for employment.

"These programs have earned the gold seal of approval for automotive instruction," said Dr. Terri Lozier, U-46 Assistant Superintendent of Secondary Schools Instruction and Equity. "This kind of national accreditation is exactly what we're trying to increase in various fields as the district works to enhance our career pathways for students."

Three U-46 schools, including **Eastview Middle School in Bartlett**, recently recognized sixth and eighth-grade students who received awards in the 2016-17 Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Patriot's Pen youth essay contest. 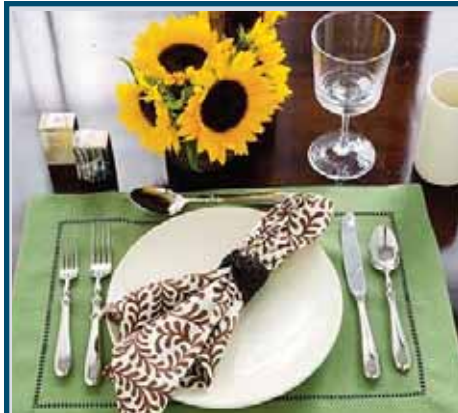

Parkway Tree Program

Through its long-running Parkway Tree Program, the Village of Bartlett has shared the cost of planting trees with homeowners in an effort to reforest Bartlett's parkways. This program has been accelerated in recent years due to the devastation caused by the emerald ash borer infestation in Illinois. The Village continues its commitment to reforestation and diversification by offering a large number of tree species again this year.

All trees available for order are 2 inches in diameter, at a cost of \$50 per tree. Due to the fixed number of trees, orders will be filled on a first come, first served basis. If the tree you order sells out, you will be contacted to make another selection.

You are only eligible to purchase a tree if you had a tree removed from your parkway or have the space for one to be planted. Trees must be spaced 30 to 40 feet apart. Other restrictions, such as proximity to street lights, hydrants, storm sewers, etc. may occur. Final planting locations will be determined by the Village.

Public Works will begin taking orders February 13 for the spring planting season.
